



WETLAND DISCOVERY POINT

An indoor and outdoor classroom that puts visitors dramatically in a wetland area where they explore and learn about these important natural places.



The building itself is an educational tool, incorporating sustainable design and certification. It has been awarded Platinum Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design by the U.S. Green Building Council, the organization's highest level of recognition. Wetland Discovery Point is the first Utah State University facility to receive LEED certification and demonstrates USU's commitment to teaching and demonstrating sustainability.

Field trips bring more than 4,000 children to the Utah Botanical Center each year. They explore a range of topics including wetland ecology, energy conservation, wise water use, insects, wildlife, and horticulture.
